



The Great Beefsteak Raid 1864

CATTLE
(BEEFSTEAK) RAID

Leaving from a point along the right flank on Boydton Road in 1864, Maj. Gen. Wade Hampton's Confederate cavalry rode 100 miles around the rear of the Union army, reaching Coggins' Point on 16 Sept. - the raiders lost 2,500 head of cattle the next day. The cattle were sent to the east of the Potomac River and slaughtered for the army at Fort Detrick, Virginia.
