



# Announcement

## 8<sup>th</sup> International Open German Cavalry Championship

September 12– 14, 2025

### General Regulations:

1. The event takes place on:

**September 12 – 14, 2025 at the stables of Agrar Crawinkel GmbH  
(Thüringeti) in Crawinkel near Gotha.**

2. The number of prizes available:

- Section competitions: all sections
- Individual competition: half of all competing riders

3. Participating horses will be stabled at the stables of Agrar Crawinkel GmbH. The straw and hay are complimentary. The participants have to bring their own feed pellets.

4. Qualified to start are all participants from the Federal Republic of Germany and foreign countries:

**Teams (4-6 riders)** for the section competitions.

**Individual riders** for the individual competitions.

5. Accommodation: Own tents or the Ohrdruf army barracks. A list of hotels is available upon request.

6. Catering on site.

7. Changing horses is only allowed within a section during the section competitions.

8. Only 2 horses per rider are allowed to start during the individual competition tests.

9. Veterinarian requirements in separate documents.

10. Minimum age of participating horses: 5 years

11. Minimum age of participating horses Minimum age of participants: 18 years.  
Special allowance can be requested upfront.



12. A few tests will be organized in **test groups**. All tests of a test group will take place at the same time. There will be a lead test (LP) and one or more follow tests (FP) in each test group. A participant will start in the lead test at a redefined start time. After riding this test, he will directly start in the following tests. This will reduce preparation time and conserve the horse. There will be the following test groups:

- Saturday morning: LP: 5ED, FP: 6ES
- Saturday afternoon: LP: 1GD 2. Teil, FP: 3GW
- Sunday morning: LP: 8EW, FP: 9EW

13. **Participants take part at their own risk.** The organizer, the organizer's assistants and anyone who is commissioned by the organizer cannot be held responsible. The same goes for the immediate family and the dependants of the participants. The participant releases the organizer and the organizer's assistants from any claims by a third party in connection with the damage done by the participant. Participants bear full responsibility before the law for any damage caused by their horses and will be held accountable.

14. **The participant is responsible for providing his own insurance.** No additional accident insurance is provided to the participants by the organizer.

15. The instructions of the organizer's assistants must be complied with. Disqualification from the event and forfeiture of registration fees may result if instructions are not properly followed. Any participants who endanger the health or the lives of other participants or other people through risky and dangerous behavior will be removed from the event. Participants are liable for any damage to people or third parties if such damage is purposefully or carelessly caused.

16. The organizer is not liable for the condition of the competition ground or the facilities. The organizer reserves the right to cancel the event if exceptional circumstances or an act of nature prevents it from occurring.

17. Any photos taken by the organizer or the organizer's assistants during the event remain the exclusive property of the "Deutscher Kavallerverband".

18. It is not allowed to take guns onto the whole ground of the event!

19. The organizer reserves the right to make changes.

## Special Regulations:

1. Entries:

Entries will be open: **July 1 – July 31, 2025**  
Closing of entries: **July 31, 2019, 20:00 (8:00 pm CET).**  
Entries only through online registration.

Online registration will be open via link on [www.kavallerie.net](http://www.kavallerie.net).

2. The committee reserves the right to:

- cancel the examination test if there are less than five entries and three participants.
- to change the announcement and the timetable/schedule

4. **Entry fee (inclusive):**

Horse without loose-box	€90,-	Horses in own organized paddocks, straw and hey

5. The entry fee needs to be paid to the bank account of “Deutscher Kavallerieverband”

at the VR-Bank Neu-Ulm/Weißenhorn **latest July 31, 2025**. Entries are just valid with the correct bank transfer. Cash payments are not possible.

6. The starting order will be determined by the organizer based on sound organizational considerations.
7. Use of the examination and tournament areas before the event is not allowed. Misconduct will lead to disqualification.
8. There will be training obstacles and targets in specially designated training areas.
9. Onsite registration is open on **Thursday, September 11th, at 15:00 (3:00 pm CET)**.
10. The actual participating horses must be registered at least 45 minutes before the examination begins. Late registration excludes participants from taking part in the event.
11. All participants must be in the preparation area at least 15 minutes before the start of the examination.



12. When riding into the competition area, the participants must gallop in front of the judges and greet them.
13. During an examination, every horse must have their program number visible on the left and right of their harness at the height of the browband. You have to bring your own start number required for participation.
14. Upon completion of an examination, the results will be made public at the registration area within an hour.
15. The awards ceremony of an examination will take place immediately after the examination (with horses). The award ceremony of a few selected examinations will take place according to special regulations in official time schedule. Judges can make changes.
16. Dress/Clothing:
  - On the competition area: Service dress according to national regulation and era without weapons.
  - During examinations: when necessary, appropriate special regulations.
17. closing parade:
  - All participating groups are asked to take part in the final parade on Sunday afternoon
